Muhammad is not the father of any of your men, but (he is) the Messenger of Allah, and the Seal of the Prophets: and Allah has full knowledge of all things.

Al Ahzab 33:40

Ye have indeed in the Messenger of Allah a beautiful pattern (of conduct) for any whose hope is in Allah and the Final day and he who engages much in the praise of Allah..

Al Ahzab 33:21

(Indeed, in the Messenger Of Allah you have a beautiful example.....)

So if they reject thee, so were rejected Messengers before thee, who came with Clear Signs and the Scriptures, and the Book of enlightenment.

Ali Imran 3: 184

Allah and His Angels sends blessings on the Prophet. O ye that believe! Send ye blessings on him and salute him with all respect.

Al Ahzab 33: 56

Those who annoy Allah and His Messenger – Allah has cursed them in this world and in the Hereafter, and has prepared for them a humiliating Punishment.

Al Ahzab 33:57

He who obeys the Messenger, obeys Allah.

Al Nisa' 4:80

And (thus O Prophet) We have sent thee as (an evidence of Our) grace towards all the worlds.

Al Anbiya' 21: 107

(We sent thee not, but as a mercy for all creatures.)

It is He who sent amongst the unlettered a Messenger from among themselves, to rehearse to them His Signs, to sanctify them, and to instruct them in Scriptures and Wisdom although - they had been in manifest error.

Al Jumu'ah 62: 2

And thou (standest) on an exalted standard of character.

Al Qalam 68:4

The Prophet is closer to the believers than their own selves and his wives are their mothers.

Al Ahzab 33: 6

O ye who believe! Put not yourselves forward before Allah and His Messenger but fear Allah: for Allah is He who hears and knows all things.

Al Hujurat 49:1

It is not fitting for a believer , man or woman, when a matter has been decided by Allah and His Messenger, to have any option about their decision: If anyone disobeys Allah and His Messenger, he is indeed on a clearly wrong path.

Al Ahzab 33: 36

O ye who believe! Obey Allah, and obey His Messenger, and those charged with authority (imbued with righteousness) among you. If ye differ in anything among yourselves, refer it to Allah and His Messenger, if ye do believe in Allah and the Last Day; that is the best, and most suitable for final determination.

Al Nisa' 4: 59

By the star when it goes down-
Your Companion is neither astray or being misled,
Nor does he say (aught) of (his own) desire,
It is no less then (divine) inspiration sent down to him

Al Najm 53: 1-4

Say: "If ye do love Allah, follow me: Allah will love you and forgive you your sins; for Allah is Oft Forgiving and Most Merciful."

Say: "Obey Allah and His Messenger": but if they turn their back, Allah loveth not those who reject faith."

Ali Imran 3:31-32

All who obey Allah and the Messenger are in the company of those on whom is the Grace of Allah – of the Prophets (who teach), the sincere (lovers of truth), the witnesses (who testify), and the righteous (who do good): Ah! What a beautiful fellowship.

Al Nisa' 4:69

The answer of the believers when summoned to Allah and His Messenger, in order that he may judge between them, is no other than this: they say, "we hear and we obey". It is such as these that will attain felicity.

It is such as obey Allah and His Messenger, and fear Allah and do right, that will win (in the end).

Al Nur 24: 51-52

Say : "Obey Allah, and obey His Messenger: but if ye turn away, he is only responsible for the duty placed on him and ye for that placed on you. If ye obey him, ye shall be on right guidance. The Messenger's duty is only to preach the clear (Message).
